Streets of Destiny Global Outreach Center, is a faith-based organization located in East Phoenix. Together we are committed to meet the needs of those less fortunate and at-risk worldwide! Our <u>Annual Back to School Event</u> is one of many community outreaches we host to give hope and opportunity to students. We encourage you to make a difference in the future.

In the last two years, we have provided free back to school supplies to over 800 students and six \$1000 College Scholarships. This year we are excited to announce that we will be offering another FOUR \$1000 Scholarships!

Applicants will need to be a high school junior or senior, obtained or working on a GED, enrolled in a local vocational (profession specific) training, community college or Arizona university to apply.

In order to ensure a fair and equitable selection process, Streets of Destiny Global Outreach Center will retain the services of individuals to represent as a scholarship team. This designated team will have sole discretion of reviewing applications, verifying recipient information, if necessary, and ultimately selecting the students for the scholarships. Selected students will be contacted directly and then announced via SOD, GOC media outlets by August 31st, 2022. All applicants will be contacted via email within one week after selected student has been contacted.

Scholarship may be paid in full or divided into two payments between the second and fourth semester of the first or following school year pending enrollment confirmation. In the event enrollment cannot be confirmed, it will be considered that the recipient has forfeit the award. At that time, the award may be used for another applicant or rolled over to the following school year.

#### **Option 1: My Walk with Christ**

Scholarship to be awarded to a student whose vision is to improve the quality of life for people by bridging culture divides in communities and passionate about social justice. Candidate must show strong record of service in the community in non school-sponsored activities or participation in extracurricular school activities. Include vision for future generations. How do you apply this vision within their life today and over the next few years?

#### **Option 3: Further Education Scholarship**

This scholarship is specifically for students who plan on working while furthering education in a specific career/occupational programs. Eligible fields include: child care, human services, teaching, nursing, physical and occupational therapy, social work, and public service. Essay should include motivation for returning to further your education. Include your current occupation and goal occupation.

### Option 4: Fine & Performing Arts Scholarship

Applicants can submit a short video or sample of their highlighted performances or artwork with abbreviated essay. List your experiences/background with letter of reference from a mentor or teacher. Essay should include how you define art. What does it mean to you and how do you want others to be inspired by your work or performances?

By signing the scholarship agreement, the applicant/recipient accepts the scholarship funds as well as the terms set by Streets of Destiny Global Outreach Center. In return, Streets of Destiny Global Outreach Center agrees to provide the specified funds, as long as those conditions are met.
